Primer	Peran STC @ 0.25 kg/m²
Topping	Mondéco Crystal @ 0.25 kg/m² (Applied at 11 mm, ground down to 9 mm)
Grout	Mondéco/Mirrazzo Grout @ up to 0.2 kg/m <sup>2</sup> Applied in 1 or 2 layers
Sealers	Flowseal PU Gloss (WB) @ 0.03 kg/m² approx. Dilute the pre-mixed product 1:1 by weight with clean water to ensure the correct application viscosity. Enhance @ 0.03 – 0.04 litres/m² in total (applied in 3 layers)  Additional layers may be applied to achieve the desired finish.

# Substrate Requirements

Concrete or screed substrate should be a minimum of 25 N/mm<sup>2</sup>, free from laitance, dust and other contamination.

The substrate should be dry to 75% RH as per BS8203 and free from rising damp and ground water pressure. If no damp proof membrane is present Hydraseal DPM can be incorporated directly beneath the Mondéco system.

#### Installation Service

The installation must be carried out by a Flowcrete approved contractor with a documented quality assurance scheme.

# Aftercare, Cleaning & Maintenance

Clean regularly using a single or double headed rotary scrubber drier in conjunction with a neutral detergent /floor maintainer and dry burnish. Maintain the surface appearance with a suitable high solids metallised floor polish as required (dependant on levels of traffic). Please contact our Technical Advisors for further details and cleaning documents.

#### Note

Mondéco/Mirrazzo is not totally colour fast and may change colour over time (exhibits a yellowing effect). Colour change depends on the UV light and heat levels present and hence the rate of change cannot be predicted. This is more noticeable in very light colours but does not compromise the product's flexibility or chemical resistance characteristics. We have endeavoured to adopt colours within our standard range which minimise this change. Separate each adjacent application bay (a day's lay) by a trim and ensure that single batch components are used within each bay. Intensively coloured products (e.g. hair colourants, medical disinfectants etc.) and plasticizer migration (e.g. from rubber tyres) can lead to irreversible discolouration in the surface.
