

Topping	Mondéco Earth (average density 2.1 kg/l) @ 18.9 kg/m <sup>2</sup> (Applied at 9 mm, ground down to 7 mm)
Grout	Mondéco/Mirrazzo Grout @ up to 0.2 kg/m² Applied in 1 or 2 layers
Sealers (1st Coat)	Flowseal PU Satin @ 0.06 kg/m² Dilute the pre-mixed product 1:1 by weight with clean water to ensure the correct application viscosity.
Sealers (2nd Coating)	Flowseal PU Satin @ 0.08 kg/m² Dilute the pre-mixed product with 500 ml (500 g) clean water per 4.6 kg unit of Flowseal PU Satin to ensure the correct application viscosity and consistent finish.

# **Substrate Requirements**

Concrete or screed substrate should be a minimum of 25 N/mm², free from laitance, dust and other contamination. The substrate should be dry to 75% RH as per BS8203 and free from rising damp and ground water pressure. If no damp proof membrane is present Flowcrete Hydraseal DPM can be incorporated directly beneath the Mondéco system.

#### Installation Service

The installation must be carried out by a Flowcrete approved contractor with a documented quality assurance scheme.

#### **Environmental considerations**

The finished system is assessed as non-hazardous to health and the environment. The long service life and seamless surface reduce the need for repairs, maintenance and cleaning. Environmental and health considerations are controlled during manufacture and application of the products by Flowcrete staff and fully trained and experienced contractors.

#### Note

Mondéco/Mirrazzo is not totally colour fast and may change colour over time (exhibits a yellowing effect). Colour change depends on the UV light and heat levels present and hence the rate of change cannot be predicted. This is more noticeable in very light colours but does not compromise the product's flexibility or chemical resistance characteristics. We have endeavoured to adopt colours within our standard range which minimise this change. Separate each adjacent application bay (a day's lay) by a trim and ensure that single batch components are used within each bay. Intensively coloured products (e.g. hair colourants, medical disinfectants etc.) and plasticizer migration (e.g. from rubber tyres) can lead to irreversible discolouration in the surface.
